## Faster Broadband for Winster?

For those waiting for faster broadband, there is news - of sorts - from Derbyshire CC. DCC have recently signed a contract with BT to spend £27m of public money to persuade BT to bring faster (optic-fibre) broadband to places that they say they won't upgrade without a subsidy. The contract has been based on a fairly broad-brush analysis, and the proposed coverage map (see [goo.gl/V85WOH](http://goo.gl/V85WOH)) is rather vague, but it looks as if - all being well - at least some of Winster should be offered considerably faster broadband sometime during 2015. Exact provision will depend on which of the green street cabinets BT choose to upgrade: details should be much clearer in about 9 months' time when BT have completed their detailed planning work. My guess is that isolated buildings outside the village will miss out, but that most people in the main part of the village will be covered.

## Wifi and Photocopying at the Burton Institute

Although there is no longer a "public user" computer at the Burton Institute, we now offer users a Wifi connection for the duration of their hire - this can be used throughout the building (and in the yard), for both laptop computers and for smartphones. To save energy, the connection is turned off when not needed: please mention when booking if you will need it turned on. Remember that the shop also offers wifi for those buying a hot drink there.

Our "public user" photocopier in the Morgue is still available to all in the village: to become a user, you need to pay a £5 deposit (which will bring you a note of the code for the door lock), then simply write your usage in the log book and we will let you know when you owe us a top-up payment. The cost is 5p per A4 side.

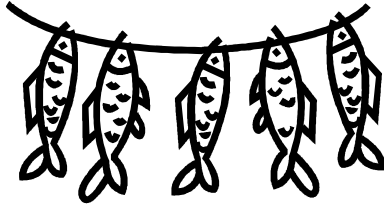
